

**Cinco Ranch High School Band**  
**South Padre Island, Texas**  
**March 21-24, 2019**

**Tuesday, March 19 – (Medication Collection)**

6:00 PM-7:30 PM All student prescription medication for the trip will be collected at this time.

- Both prescription and non-prescription drugs must be in their **original container**. Prescription medications must be labeled by the pharmacist with appropriate dosing information. There will be no more than one medication per properly labeled container.
- If you are allowed to carry medication at school (e.g., inhaler or EpiPen) you can still do so on this trip.

**Thursday, March 21 – (School day, Departure)**

Maximum amount of luggage PER PERSON on this trip:

- A. One “carry on size” suitcase – packed and delivered to the band room Thursday morning – please do not bring a full size “check in” size piece of luggage as space is limited.
- B. One small briefcase-sized bag or backpack

Note: Thursday afternoon, students are responsible for getting luggage, concert instrument, and music to the bus. Loading crew will load it under the bus for you.

WHAT TO WEAR: **2018 Maroon Show Shirt**, comfortable shorts or pants, tennis shoes. (Remember the bus could be hot and/or cold)

- 10:00 PM Check in to hotel. (**MEDICATION DISBURSEMENT in Lobby**)  
Take luggage and instrument to your rooms. Everything must be taken off the bus at this time.  
Move quickly to your rooms, there will be other guests at the hotel sleeping. **This is considered quiet time, please stay in your rooms, off of the balconies and keep the noise level down.**

**WHAT TO WEAR WHEN**

Thursday bus to South Padre:

2018 Cinco Ranch Band maroon show shirt, comfortable shorts or pants, tennis shoes. (Remember the bus could be hot and/or cold)

Friday Clinic:

2019 Spring Trip Shirt, Adidas pants, tennis shoes.

Saturday Schlitterbahn:

Any Cinco Ranch High School t-shirt that is Maroon, comfortable shorts or pants, tennis shoes.

Sunday bus to Katy:

Any Cinco Ranch High School t-shirt that is maroon, comfortable shorts or pants, tennis shoes. (Remember the bus could be hot and/or cold)

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**General Trip Guidelines**

**Luggage** – Be sure all your luggage and instrument cases are clearly marked with your name, address and phone number. One suitcase, and one backpack only!

**Schedule** – Keep a copy of the itinerary with you at all times. Be punctual! Wear a watch. It is not fair to the rest of the group to ever have to wait for you.

**Security** – Most of you will be carrying money and valuables. Be aware that these things can “disappear” at any time. Be careful! Don’t leave luggage, purses, cameras, bags, horn cases, etc. in an unsecured area.

**Shoplifting** – Everywhere you go and whatever you do, be sure to handle all merchandise in an open, straightforward manner. Do not give anyone the slightest impression that you could be doing something that could get you thrown in jail.

**Authority of Adults** – Directors, chaperones, hotel personnel, and many other adults are always in charge. These adults are present to help you have a fun and safe trip. They ARE NOT present to “wait on you.” Be polite and respectful at all times. Cheerfully follow instructions the first time they are given.

**Public Displays of Affection** - These are strictly prohibited at all times, in all places, when traveling with the Cinco Band. Repeated violations may result in serious disciplinary action.

**Stay in a Group** – Everywhere you go, have at least one “Cinco Band Buddy” with you of the same gender. This includes the hotel property and all sightseeing trips. NEVER go off alone!! Any student found alone by an adult will be disciplined.

**Beach and Ocean** – Directors will set the beach boundaries upon arrival. No one is to go beyond **6 inches deep** into the ocean

- Hotel Guidelines** -
- a. Keep your room reasonably neat and clean at all times
  - b. All pay items (movies, room service, etc.) will not be available  
This also includes: golf, horseback riding, waverunners/jet skis, parasailing, banana boat rides, and the spa
  - c. Chaperones can and will enter rooms at any time for inspections
  - d. Any suspicious activity will be investigated immediately
  - e. **Curfew will be strictly adhered to – your door will be taped**
  - f. Quiet hours will be strictly enforced – **This means being quiet while in your room!**
  - g. The hotel will have many other guests, so be courteous and quiet
  - h. Never congregate in the hallways

**Citizenship** – Always be a great citizen! Remember that all future band trips depend upon what happens on this trip.

**Illness/Injury** – Please report to a chaperone quickly if you ever start to feel ill or are hurt.

**Medicine** – If you take prescription medication, it must be kept with the band directors. Let us know well in advance of the trip departure if you will need our nurse to assist you during the trip. Medication disbursement times are clearly marked throughout the itinerary. **It is your responsibility to take your medication.**

**Get some sleep** - On a busy trip like this, it is crucial for you to get as much rest as possible. At “lights out,” try to get to sleep quickly.

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**TRIP BEHAVIOR CONTRACT**

**Band member AND Parent must initial by each entry:**

\_\_\_\_\_ I agree to abide by all guidelines of the KISD Dress Code and the KISD Discipline Management Plan and Student Code of Conduct while on this trip. I also understand that all KISD Discipline Policies and CRHS Band Discipline Policies are in effect while I am on this trip. I understand that this trip is a continuation of the school day.

\_\_\_\_\_ I agree to represent my family, my fellow band members, my community, and myself in the most professional manner possible. I will exhibit my strong character by treating every person with courtesy and respect.

\_\_\_\_\_ I am a responsible young adult, and as such, I take full responsibility for my actions.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that this trip is an earned privilege, and that all future trips and privileges for the Cinco Ranch Band and me depend on the complete success of this trip.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that the CRHS Band Directors, Chaperones, Bus Drivers, and numerous other adults are always in charge. These adults are present to help the band have a safe, successful, and fun trip. I will cheerfully follow their instructions the first time.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that any lack of courtesy or respect to an adult or fellow Band member, or any uncooperative behavior on this trip may result in my dismissal from the CRHS Band program.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that any lack of courtesy or respect to an adult or fellow band member, or any uncooperative behavior on this trip may result in my being sent home at my parent's expense.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that if I fail to use good judgment while on this trip, I may be sent home at my parent's expense.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that I may not have my cell phone with me during my band's clinic.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that "public displays of affection" are prohibited. I agree to use good judgment. I will be referred to the appropriate principal upon return from the trip. Violations of this policy will result in loss of privileges while on the trip.

\_\_\_\_\_ I agree to the following hotel guidelines:

- **No one is permitted in any rooms except for those students assigned to the room. Violation of this rule could result in the students being sent home at the parents' expense and students may be removed from the Band program.**
- Keep my room reasonably neat and clean.
- Pay items are off limits (room service, outside deliveries, movie, etc.) Parents are responsible for payment of any fees if this rule is violated.
- Chaperones will enter rooms at any time for inspection.
- Remain courteous to the hotel's other guests.
- Property damage to the room will be the student's responsibility.
- Curfew will be strictly enforced. My room will be taped closed. I will be sent home at my parents' expense if I am out of my room after curfew.
- Late for curfew may result in loss of privileges while on the trip and future travel privileges may be lost. I may be removed from the Band
- Students will call chaperones or directors in case of emergency.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will get sleep. My band is depending on me to be rested so that I will perform to the best of my ability.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will complete make-up work for school as quickly as possible.

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\_\_\_\_\_ I agree to read and follow the trip itinerary by wearing the correct uniform for each event. I will be sure to Check-In at the specified time. I understand that failure to meet these guidelines may result in a loss of privileges for the day/event.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will remain in a group of no less than 2 Cinco Ranch Band members at all times. I will not befriend strangers.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that any violation of local, state, or federal law(s) will be turned over to the local law enforcement authorities. If the student is returned to the directors while the trip is still in progress, the student will be sent home immediately at the parent's expense. Appropriate disciplinary action will follow upon return to school.

\_\_\_\_\_ Any Cinco Band member who violates numerous guidelines (even in minor fashion) will be sent home for lack of good judgment.

\_\_\_\_\_ The possession or use of any tobacco or alcohol product, drugs, chemicals, inhalants, or other intoxicants/mood-altering drugs is prohibited. Any Cinco Band member violating this policy will be sent home at the parent's expense and referred to the appropriate campus administrator.

\_\_\_\_\_ "Possession" is defined as being in the same area with tobacco, alcohol products, drugs, chemicals, inhalants, or other intoxicants/mood-altering drugs. Students who are in the room or area with students who are "using" these substances MUST report usage and possession to the director, chaperone, and administrator immediately in order to avoid being penalized for possession.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that the violation of any of the rules or guidelines listed in this document or in the KISD Discipline Management Plan, Spring Trip Itinerary and Student Code of Conduct may result in permanent removal from the Cinco Ranch Band Program.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that if I am sent home for any reason, my parents are responsible for paying the full cost of my return trip home to Katy.

I have initialed all guidelines of this behavior contract and agree, as a Cinco Ranch Band Member, to abide by them.
