

Grading Policy and Rules for Football Game Performances

Please understand thousands of people are watching you, everything you do and say will come back on OUR band program. That goes for the “good” as well as the “bad”.

If you do everything required for the game and follow instructions, you will receive a 100.

Be polite! The chaperones, bus drivers, and all other adults are there to help OUR program. Say “please” and “thank you”.

Pre-Game

- Late for run through = -20 pts
- Missing inspection = -30 pts

Uniform

- Eating in uniform (whether on the bus or in the stands) – you will be told to remove your uniform, be required to sit outside the band set-up and given a maximum grade of 50.
- Incorrect uniform = -100 pts (black shoes, socks, gloves, gauntlets. Hat, etc.)
- Wearing uniform incorrectly = -30pts
The jacket is either completely on or completely off. You will be told with enough time to get it right. Hats are to be worn correctly at all times, never wear your hat backwards.
- Make-up and jewelry at game = -100 (no performance)
Take off the bracelets, rings and necklaces. Do not add anything to the uniform like ribbons.
Hair bows or bands need to be black or maroon.
- Borrowing items from uniform room = -10 pts/item
- No poncho = -10pts

Game

- Uniform, Instrument, Cinco uniform, and Music are the only items allowed in the stands.
- Moving or talking at attention = -10 pts. each offence
 - National Anthem and the other schools Alma Mater are to specific examples
- Not following directions of directors, chaperones or student leaders – required to sit outside the band set-up and given a maximum grade of 50.
- Cursing - required to sit outside the band set-up and given a maximum grade of 50.
- Missing flip folder and music = -30 pts.

Grading Policy and Rules for Football Game Performances

- Not playing on stand tunes = -10 pts. each offence
- Missing individual stand tune music = -10pts/song (max - 30)
- Moving from spot in stands without permission = -10 pts each offence
- Bathroom breaks are for emergencies only. Contact a parent chaperone.

Post-Game

- Students **must** ride home from games with the band. (Under special circumstances students may ride home with, and only with, their parents. A district alternate travel form must be on file with Mr. Jones prior to the event.)
- No student will be released to anyone other than their parents without special approval from Mr. Cross, Principal, prior to the game.
- Be picked up promptly when we return to CRHS. Your directors would like to go home!
- Missing a performance will result in a 0 for that performance and will start the process of removal from the band program.
