Marching Season-What does that look like?

- Summer Band Camp – Mandatory, begins **July 24, 2023** - see Charms calendar for specific times - first week is **7:00 to 4:00**
- First Day of School – **August 16, 2023**
- Practices after school 3 days, and games most weeks
- October is when most of the competitions occur; it is a very busy band month (*nickname: BandTober*)
- Band Activities
 - Marching contests, football games, pep rallies, Homecoming parade, BBQ preview/premier, Holiday Dinner, and more!

What you need to know as a Student:

We will have two shows this fall - a Spirit Show, and a Competition Show. Everyone will march in the Spirit Show. For the Competition Show, you will need to earn a spot.

- Every incoming 9th grader must have a **physical** to participate in marching band. See forms on the website. On May 24th, CRHS offers physicals for \$30 - this physical form must be turned in to Mr. Davis by July 24th to participate in Summer Band.
- If you want to be considered for the Competition Show, you need to **submit a marching video and a playing video**. Links are on the website.
- Marching practices have a “uniform” of a gray or white shirt, athletic shorts, and good tennis shoes.
- Game days: we will have a run through in a “run through uniform” of a CR Cougar Band gray shirt with black “CR” shorts. After dinner in the commons, students change into the band uniform for the game. Uniforms are kept at the school and are checked in/out every game day or marching competition day.

After Marching Season

December: re-audition to set Spring Concert Band placement

- Wind Ensemble (varsity concert season spring band)
- Symphonic Band (non-varsity)
- Concert 1 & 2 (sub-non-varsity)
- Jazz Band (optional; extra band period, audition)

Encore ends when marching season ends - after the last game.

- Concert Band uniforms are distributed.
- Boys need a tux shirt - more info coming.
- Region Band auditions occur during marching season - we highly encourage all students to try out. It helps tremendously with proficiency on your instrument.
- Solo and Ensemble Contest: Feb-March
- UIL Concert and Sightreading contests: April
- Spring Trip: April
- Band Awards Night: May

Band Member Marcher Estimated Cost

Money Day - Saturday, August 5, 2023 - Required First Year Band Marching Student

- Approximately **\$500-\$600** for minimum required items - *includes a \$50 Transportation fee - paid to the band-forwarded to the district- DO NOT PAY THIS ON PAY N GO - we pay this to the district in one payment - there is also an \$80 instrument maintenance for school owned instruments. We like the majority of this money to be paid that day, but will work with you if you need to pay over time.*
- Band fee is \$200, down from years past (included in \$600)(meals before all events, uniform maintenance, show costs, etc.).
- Lots of items are one-time purchase.
- Optional spirit items, and duplicate items.

Returning Band members -

\$200 for Band fee, plus transportation fee, & required show shirt

- Encore has already had their Money Day; merchandise will be distributed in July.

What does the Booster Club do?

- Coordinates volunteer needs - chaperones, etc.
- Raises funds for band above and beyond what Katy ISD can provide
- Manage the finances of the non-profit

- Handles uniform sizing and distribution
- Supports this band in every way we are able

Booster Membership Perks

- **\$25 Maroon Level** - Voting privileges at Band Booster General Meetings, and a Band Booster Car decal.
- **\$75 Bronze Level** - All privileges of the Maroon level, plus name in concert programs as a supporter of The Band.
- **\$125 Silver Level** - All privileges of the Bronze level, plus Photo Opportunity during the last game of the regular season in the stands, and before the game on the football field with your student.
- **\$250 Gold Level** - All privileges of the Silver level, plus four reserved seats at the spring concert.
- **\$500 Platinum Level** - All privileges of the Gold level, plus priority seating for 2 at the End of Year Band Awards Night.

- Spots fill quickly. Sign up at Money Day (*first Saturday in Aug!*)

- Most donations are given this day, electronically, but checks and cash are also taken over the weeks following.

- This used to be our biggest fundraiser, selling mums and garters to the entire student body.
